
The South Carolina House Democratic Caucus believes

Although the economy has improved, and the state budget has grown, GOP leadership in Columbia have yet to restore state funding to support our colleges, universities and technical schools. The lack of state support has led to a decline in in-state students and a rise in tuition cost. This is simply unacceptable.
